Idaho's Experimental Program to Stimulate Competitive Research (EPSCoR) is seeking student and faculty applicants for summer and academic year research and internships. The MURI Program is designed to engage undergraduates in paid summer and academic year research experiences to study within a wide range of topics broadly related to the Management of Idaho's Landscapes for Ecosystem Services (MILES) project. We are currently recruiting students with interests in ecosystem functions, visualization, environmental science, environmental science, geospatial sciences, land use planning, and the effects of urbanization on wildlife, wildfires, and recreation. Students interested in social sciences such as political science, history, geography, economics, economic modeling are also encouraged to apply. We also encourage students to visit with professors to discuss potential projects and to help with the placement process.

Idaho EPSCoR strongly encourages participation of students and faculty from Idaho's 2-yr and 4-yr colleges and universities. Up to 60 MURI positions will be offered each year across Idaho, with a goal of recruiting a large number of students traditionally underrepresented in STEM fields.
